

A BOAT TRIP ON THE RIVER THAMES

1. Welcome to our boat trip on The River Thames. Our JOURNEY begins at Westminster, the British Parliament, and Big Ben, the famous clock tower. It's the symbol of London.
2. Next we pass the London eye It's 135 metres tall and you can enjoy amazing views of London from the top.
3. After London Eye you can see The Royal Festival Hall, a concert hall for Classical music. Then you pass under Waterloo Bridge and Blackfriars Bridge.
4. Look up for a view of St. Paul's Cathedral which was built after the Great Fire in the 17th 1666
5. Opposite the cathedral you can see the Tate Modern Gallery and the Shakespeare's Globe Theatre.
6. After London Bridge you can see the Monument, which marks the site of the bread shop where, in 1666, the Great Fire of London started and destroyed most of the city.
7. Next there is the Tower of London, home of the Crown Jewels.
8. Then we pass under the Tower bridge, opened in 1894, by Prince Albert, Queen Victoria's husband. Now we get to Docklands. In the past this was the Port of London, but now there are elegant restaurants and pubs there. The famous writer, Charles Dickens often drank in the pub called the Grapes
9. Finally you see the tall tower of Canary Wharf, with its business centre.
10. The boat trip ends at Greenwich, the point of Zero longitude, where they mesure Greenwich Mean Time. Have a nice day. Good bye.
